Terms of Reference



Reporting to the Para badminton Committee, the Para badminton Commission is responsible for providing technical advice on regulations, policies, programmes, event development and the promotion of Para badminton.

Scope of Work

1. Regularly review the Para badminton competition regulations, policies and other Para badminton rules including classification regulations and make recommendations to the Para badminton Committee and Events Committees to enhance these.
2. Ensure all regulations and recommended amendments are in-line with IPC codes and compliance requirements.
3. Review the annual competition schedule and provide input on calendar development.
4. Assist with the drafting of policies for increasing the quality international Para badminton competitions.
5. Assist with the planning and development of materials and training programmes for the professional development of personnel in Para badminton – classifiers and other technical officials, event organisers, administrators as well as coaches and team manager and other members of the entourage.
6. Assist with the development of coaching programmes to develop Para badminton talent and the pathways from recreational to elite performance.
7. Assist with the development of plans to promote Para badminton, its programmes, players and events.
8. Provide input into membership development around Para badminton and the integration of Para badminton into BWF existing membership structures.
9. Provide input into the programme of medal events and qualification systems for the Paralympic Games
