

Disciplinary Committee Summary Report

Incident	Breach of Players Code of Conduct – Clause 4.5 and 4.16 in match 723 of the Women’s Doubles match – Court 2.
Players	HA Jung Eun / KIM Min Jung (KOR)

Overview

Following the conclusion of match 724, Women’s Doubles, on Court 3 between **HA Jung Eun / KIM Min Jung (KOR)** and JAUHARI Meiliana / POLII Greysia written statements were submitted from the Umpire and Service Judge, Referee and the Deputy Referee describing the conduct of the players on court and the actions taken by the officiating team.

The BWF Disciplinary Committee was constituted and met late on 31 July 2012 to consider if there was sufficient evidence to conduct a hearing to consider alleged breaches of the Players Code of Conduct – Clause 4.5 and Clause 4.16.

The Disciplinary Committee considered the reports submitted, the match result sheet and the video material of match play and determined that there was sufficient evidence to constitute a Hearing Panel.

The Hearing Panel took place on 1 August 2012 and was attended by the two players concerned, a players representative, a representative from the players Federation and the coach.

Disciplinary Committee Decision

The BWF Disciplinary Committee under the BWF’s Code of Conduct found that **HA Jung Eun / KIM Min Jung (KOR)** had breached Clause 4.5 and Clause 4.16 of the players Code of Conduct.

The Committee ruled that the players:

- shall be disqualified from the Badminton Competition of the London Olympic Games.

Players, through their Member Association, have the right of appeal to the BWF Appeals Committee.
