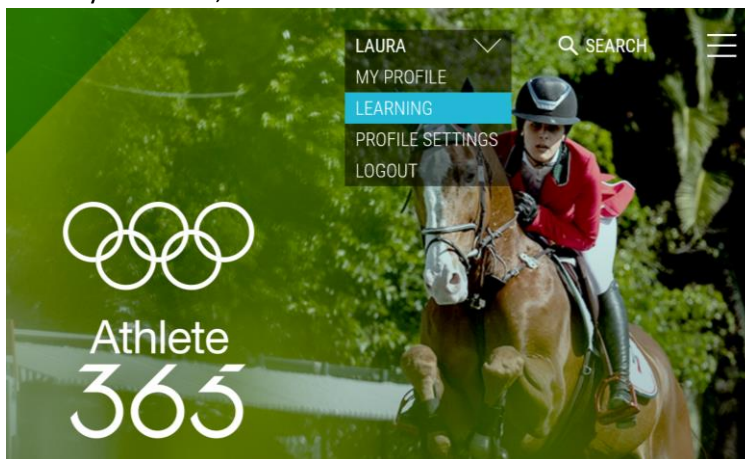


## Access instructions

1. Go to <https://www.olympic.org/athlete365>
2. Create an account, **indicating your exact country and sport (badminton).**
3. Under your name, select LEARNING



4. Click on AWARENESS-RAISING PROGRAMME – MANIPULATION OF COMPETITIONS to access the course in English. Other languages are available right below.
