GENERAL RULES	<p>The competition is organized in accordance with the General Competition Regulations and with the specific regulations of the HSBC BWF World Tour Super 750.</p> <p>The Tournament will be run strictly in accordance with the HSBC BWF World Tour regulations.</p>
ONLINE ENTRIES	<p>Member Associations are advised to log on to Yonex French Open 2019 and submit the entries online at : https://bwf.tournamentsoftware.com/sport/tournament.aspx?id=7BDB372B-3688-490E-A8A5-AED6CFBA192C</p> <p>You will require a username and password to submit your entries and this can be obtained from the BWF: please contact S. Ramachandran : s.ramachandran@bwfbadminton.org.</p> <p>The online entry page will close immediately on the entries closing date September 10th at 11:59 PM (GMT +8:00), hours BWF Headquarters time and you are required to submit the entries on time. Late entries will not be accepted.</p> <p><u>Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9</u></p>

	<p>GCR 7.9: "In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."</p> <p>No entry forms are required by Member Associations.</p> <p>When the entries are sent using the BWF Online Entry System, after the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send an Entry Confirmation to all participating Member Associations confirming the receipt of final entries.</p> <p>This confirmation is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline. The Member Associations shall contact BWF immediately if such confirmation is not received by Wednesday by noon BWF Headquarters time following close of entries. Any objection to the entries should be notified to BWF.</p> <p>Following the close of entries if no objection is received by BWF by Thursday 23.59 hours BWF Headquarters time the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints / objections shall be entertained thereafter.</p> <p>No entry fee is payable by any competitor nominated as entrant by the national association.</p>
MAIN AND RESERVE	<p>World Ranking date:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Tuesday 10th of September shall be used to prepare the MQ report. ▪ Friday 13th of September : publish date for the MQ report.
WITHDRAWALS	<p>Any notification of withdrawals with appropriate certification must be given immediately to the Tournament Organizers by email.</p> <p>Withdrawals made after Monday 30th of September for whatever reason shall be subject to a penalty as mentioned in the HSBC BWF World Tour regulations.</p>
SEEDING AND DRAWS	<p>Seeding of players shall be done by BWF on Tuesday 24th of September and published on Friday 27th of September.</p> <p>The draws will be conducted in accordance with the HSBC BWF World Tour regulations on Tuesday 1st of October.</p>
SCORING SYSTEM	Rally Point System = 3 * 21 points
COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS AND WARM-UP TIME	<p>All events will be on a strict timetable system. Competitors should be ready to play 30 minutes before their scheduled time. Competitors who are not ready to play at their scheduled time will be disqualified.</p> <p>On the court, before a game, warm-up time is limited to 2 minutes.</p>

DOPING CONTROL	<p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.</p> <p>Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. 5. CLOTHING, ADVERTISING REGULATIONS & BADMINTON INTEGRITY

ADVERTISING	BWF Competition Regulation 24 will apply. Advertising on clothing shall be in accordance with the prevailing regulation of the HSBC BWF World Tour. The updated GCR is published on BWF website. (Linked here) Advertising for tobacco and alcohol companies is completely forbidden by the French law.
NAMES AND COLOURS	<p>BWF Competition Regulations 20 to 24 and any subsequent regulations will apply. The BWF Regulations require players' names to be on the back of their shirts and give the option of also having their country and/or advertising beneath the name. This Regulation also applies to the Qualifying Rounds.</p> <p>We remind you that as of 1 July 2016, referees and umpires are required to enforce the regulation that the name on the back of the player shirt must match the Last Name/Family Name as entered by the Member Association in the BWF Player Database.</p> <p>It is mandatory that, in the main draw onwards, the opposing pairs in each match wear significantly different colours from each other.</p> <p>In Doubles: It is mandatory for doubles partners to wear same colour from main draw onwards.</p> <p>In the event that the opposing players/pairs involved in a match wish to wear the same colored clothing, the player/pair ranked lower (using the BWF World Ranking used to produce the Main & Qualifying (M & Q) Report will be required to wear clothing of a different colour.</p>
OTHER REGULATIONS	Please refer to the BWF General Competition Regulations for additional obligation and regulation concerning clothing.
BADMINTON INTEGRITY	<p>Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.</p> <p>To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.</p> <p>Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.</p> <p>For more information, please refer to BWF's website: https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-match-fixing-overview/</p>

<p>TRANSPORTATION</p>	<p>Transfers between Paris’ airports and train stations are provided for people staying in official hotels. Paris airports and train stations concerned :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Airports : Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG), Orly Airport (ORY), ▪ Train stations : Gare de Lyon, Gare d’Austerlitz, Gare du Nord, Gare de l’Est, Gare Saint Lazare. <p>If players don’t stay in an official hotel, transfer from Airports and train stations will be provided but the drop off will be located at Coubertin Stadium.</p> <p>Please submit your final travel details no later than 29th of September, to transport@yonexifb.com.</p>
