The Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by the Thursday (next day of the entries closing date) by noon BWF Headquarters time (+08.00h GMT) following the closure of entries. If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday (second day after the entries closing day) 23.59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+08.00h GMT) following the close of entries, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections shall be entertained after this point.

15. Clothing & Advertising	<p>15.1. Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with the General Competition Regulations of Badminton World Federation. (GCR 20 - 24)</p> <p>15.2. The player's name on the back of clothing shall be identical with the name registered as the Last Name (or an abbreviation thereof) in the BWF Player database. Last Name is defined as the family name, surname or similar name under the respective naming protocol of the Member country (GCR 23.3)</p> <p>15.3. <u>Mandatory Clothing Regulations</u></p> <p>15.3.1. Name of player is MANDATORY from the first day of the event.</p> <p>15.3.2. From Quarter Finals onwards, doubles partners must wear clothing of the same color.</p> <p>15.3.3. From Quarter Finals onwards, opposing players must wear clothing of significantly different colors from each other.</p>	
16. Withdrawals	<p>16.1. Notification of withdrawal(s) with reason must be given immediately to UAE Table Tennis and Badminton Association by email and must be supported by a medical certificate. The organizers may require documentary evidence to support withdrawals for any other reason.</p> <p>16.2. <p>28. Regulations Specific to UAE</p>	<p>About Dubai and UAE – check the Official UAE Fact Sheet</p> <p>Dubai is the largest and most populous city in the United Arab Emirates (UAE). It is located on the southeast coast of the Persian Gulf and is the capital of the Emirate of Dubai, one of the seven emirates that make up the country.</p> <p>Dress code: The UAE has a modest dress code, which is part of Dubai's criminal law. Most malls in the UAE have a dress code displayed at entrances. At Dubai's malls, females should cover their shoulders and knees; therefore, women are not permitted to wear sleeveless tops. However, people can wear swimwear at the pools and beaches.</p> <p>Religion: Islam is the official religion in the UAE; the practice of other religions is allowed.</p> <p>Language: The official language of the UAE is Arabic. Other widely spoken languages include Bengali, English, Farsi, Hindi, Malayalam, Mandarin, Nepali, Russian, Sinhalese, Tagalog and Urdu.</p> <p>Time: The UAE is 4 hours ahead of GMT.</p> <p>Climate: The UAE maintains a desert climate. It is warm and sunny in the winter, and during the summer, it is hot and humid.</p> <p>During November, the average temperature is 25°C (30°C to 18°C max-min).</p> <p>Currency: The Emirati Dirham is the official currency of the UAE, abbreviated officially as AED. The UAE Dirham is pegged to the USD. 1 USD = AED 3.6725</p> <p>Working days: Government and semi-government offices operate from Sunday to Thursday.</p> <p>Airports: Dubai has two airports viz. Dubai International Airport (IATA code: DXB) and Al Maktoum Airport (IATA code: DWC). The DXB is at the heart of the city and close to the official hotel and the venue and a preferred disembarkation point for the participants.
