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<p>Entries</p>	<p>Each Member Association shall be entitled to enter in each age group, up to 4 men and 4 women in singles events, 8 men and 8 women in level doubles events and 4 men and 4 women in mixed doubles event.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Singles – 4 males + 4 females 2. Doubles – 8 males + 8 females 3. Mixed – 4 males + 4 females <p>A player can compete in not more than one singles, one doubles and one mixed doubles event in any eligible age groups. E.g. a male player eligible in 45+ age category, can enter in 45+ Men's Singles, then he will not be eligible to play in Men's Singles event in any other age group.</p> <p>Note: Passports will be checked against date of birth in BWF headquarters and also by the Referees at the venue against the original copy of Passport.
