



TOTAL BWF WORLD PARA-BADMINTON CHAMPIONSHIPS INVITATION

Dear Participating Member Associations & National Paralympic Committees

The 12th Para-Badminton World Championships will be held at the St. Jakobshalle in Basel, Switzerland August 20th - August 25th 2019.

It will be a World Championship with a number of important changes. For the first time:

- Title sponsorship by BWF major events partner TOTAL.
- players will qualify for entry through the World ranking
- the Championships are held for the first time in Basel, Switzerland
- Uniquely the Badminton World Championships and Para-Badminton World Championships will take place at the same time at the same venue

The Para-Badminton World Championships are the last major event before Badminton celebrates its debut at the Paralympics.

The local organisers in Basel are making a great effort to promote our sport prior to its debut in the 2020 Paralympics.

Minimum Entries / Combinations

If entries are not sufficient for a group draw followed by a knock-out draw, a single group format shall apply.

If there are less than four (4) entries or less than two (2) represented countries in a particular event, then events may be combined – Sport Classes and or men & women – in accordance with Para-Badminton General Competition Regulation 9.1.4 and 9.1.5 – see <http://bwfcorporate.com/statutes/>

Accepted Player Status

Only the following Classification Status are accepted for the World Championships, Confirmed (C) and Fixed-Review-Date (FRD) – with a date after the World Championships.

International Representation

Regulations regarding International Representation applies to this event. Section 5.5 - Para-Badminton Competition Regulations (PBCR), Article 6 ([link](#))

Entry Restrictions per Country per Event:

Entries to the Championships will be determined in accordance to BWF Statutes, Section 5.5.6 - Para-Badminton World and Continental Championships, Article 9 ([link](#))

Non Playing personnel

In accordance with agreement with the BWF, the number of accompanying (non-playing) officials permitted to receive official accreditation is based on the following team sizes.

- For 3 or less players 2 Official
- For 4-7 players 4 Officials
- For 8-15 players 6 Officials
- For 16 or more 8 Officials



Entry Fee

- 300 CHF per person – is for athletes and officials accompanying the team (as shown above)
- 400 CHF for additional team officials accompanying the team
- is **non-refundable** if the person does not attend the competition (including withdrawal), (exception: **ONLY** refunded if there are not enough entries to have a competition)

Entry fees includes:

- **Local transportation:**
 - from Basel Airport or railway station Basel SBB to the official hotel between Friday, 16 August – Tuesday, 27 August
 - from hotel to the venue between Saturday, 17 August – Sunday, 25 August
- **Meals:**
 - lunch from Sunday, 18 August to Sunday, 25 August at the main venue
 - **Welcome dinner** Sunday, 18 August
 - dinner from Monday, 19 August to Saturday, 24 August at the main venue.
- **Tickets:** Free entrance for both world Championships. Please note: you will have to sit in the designated sectors. Wheelchair athletes will also have their own designated sector.
- **Others:** the fee also covers participation fee, accreditation and commemorative souvenir

Fees must be paid in full to the host organisers by **Friday, 5 July 2019**. Failure to do so may affect participants' entry to the tournament. There is no refund of part of the entry fee for non-attendance at the Welcome dinner. It is expected that all athletes will attend and support this good initiative by the organisers.

Part 2 – Regulation, Registration and Classification

Registration

The competition will be organised and run in accordance with the Classification Regulations, Para-Badminton General Competition Regulations, General Competition Regulations and Laws of Badminton. The below are a few reminders of important regulations. Please see the BWF website for the full details.

Withdrawals All withdrawals notification should be sent to the BWF, Referee, TD and Tournament Organiser in writing as soon as possible – at least 14 days before first competition day. BWF Penalties may apply to withdrawals received within 14 days of the first competition day. Any withdrawal must be accompanied by the appropriate certification.

Entry / Forms You need to **fill in (in addition to the Online entry system) all forms which are applicable for you** to enter the **BWF Para-Badminton World Championships** as a player of a team, as an accompanying person or as an individual player:

- Travel arrangement
- Hotel reservation and rooming list
- Visa application (if needed)
- Team manager and official's accreditation

Conditions of play The tournament will be played in accordance with BWF Laws of Badminton and Para-Badminton General Competition Regulations – see the BWF website: <http://bwfcorporate.com/statutes/>

In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final.

The World Championships also ask participants to pay special attention to BWF Code of Ethics (BWF Statute 2.1), Player Commitment Regulations (BWF Statute 5.3.6), Players' Code of Conduct (BWF Statute 2.2.4), Technical Officials Code of Conduct (BWF Statute 2.2.5), Coaches and Educators Code of Conduct (BWF Statute 2.2.6), Code of Conduct in relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results (BWF Statute 2.4), and Table of Offences and Penalties (Para-Badminton) (BWF Statute 2.6)

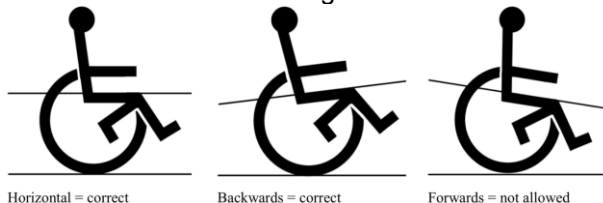
Readiness to Play All events will be run on a strict time scale. **Competitors must be ready to play 30 minutes before the scheduled match time.** If players are not ready to play at the scheduled time they will be disqualified. Any changes to the schedule of play will be announced by the Referee.

Warm-up / practicing On court, warm up time is limited to a maximum of 2 minutes.

Equipment

The following points are essential extracts from the BWF Additional Equipment for Para-Badminton - Section 4.1.7 - Regulations 1 to 3 ([link](#))

- Wheelchair
- A player's feet must be fixed to the footrest of the wheelchair.
 - The seat of the wheelchair, including any padding can be horizontal or angled backwards. It cannot be angled forwards.



- Prosthetic limbs
- The use of prosthetic limbs is not allowed in category SU5

Note: Equipment regulations will strictly be adhered to at this event. Failure to comply may affect an athlete's eligibility to go on court and compete or be disqualified after play.

Clothing & Advertising

The following points are essential extracts from the BWF Para-Badminton General Competition - Section 5.5 - Regulations 15 to 19 ([link](#)). The decision of the Referee at the Tournament shall be final. BWF penalties may apply to any violation of these regulations.

- Clothing
- Regulations regarding advertising apply only to clothing worn during play and during prize ceremonies.

For the purpose of these Regulations, an article of clothing shall be defined as anything worn or carried by a player during play, except the racket, and including, but not limited to, pullovers, shirts, shorts, skirts, socks, shoes, headbands (including headscarves and turbans), towels, wristbands, bandages, gloves, tracksuit pants and medical supports.

For Para-Badminton, regulations for shorts govern tracksuit pants as written in clause 19.

Athletes must ensure that parts of their trousers (that is without limbs) must not be left dangling from the wheelchair while competing on court. It must be tied / secured before going on court.

- Colour
- Singles matches**

Each player must wear, as far as colour and design is concerned, shirts and shorts (or equivalent articles of clothing) **throughout a match** in accordance with the BWF Statutes, and no change of colours is allowed.

Doubles matches

Each player in a given pair must wear shirts and shorts (or equivalent articles of clothing) of the **same colour and similar design throughout a match** in accordance with the BWF Statutes. No change of colours is allowed.

Television Court

BWF may insist that Players on the television court(s) change the colour of their shirt or shorts or skirt or dress to avoid problems with the implementation of the on court virtual advertising

- Advertising
- The shirt may carry advertising as defined below:

- A maximum of one advertisement may appear on each of the following locations; left sleeve, right sleeve, left shoulder, right shoulder, left collar, right collar, right chest, left chest and centre chest. The shoulder is defined as the visible part of the shoulder on the front of the shirt. There must be **no more than five (5) advertisements in total** and National flags or emblems for the purpose of this regulation count as advertisements. Each advertisement, including National flags or emblems, must be 20 square centimetres (20 cm²) or less.
- One advertising contained in a band of uniform width not exceeding 10 centimetres **on the front** and not exceeding 5 centimetres **on the back**; such a band may be at any angle and may be on the front of the shirt, the back of the shirt, or both.

Other clothing & Equipment	<p>Each sock may carry two advertisements (including manufacturers' logos/emblems) of 20 square centimetres (20 cm²) or less. The total number of advertisements allowed on each leg/foot is just two should a Player wear a compression/support sock as well as a regular sock.</p> <p>Advertising on shoes is accepted subject to the make and model of shoe being made available in the open market.</p> <p>Additional Equipment for Para-Badminton, such as wheelchairs, prothesis and crutches may carry identification of the manufacturer as generally used on products sold.</p> <p>Manufacturers may not put BWF logo on any equipment without prior written approval from the BWF.</p> <p>Gloves worn by player shall be restricted to One Identification of the Manufacturer per item, to a maximum size of 8 cm².</p>
Lettering on player's clothing	<p>Lettering shall be all in capital letters in the Roman alphabet (except as in Regulation 16.5.2), and in one single colour contrasting with that of the shirt.</p> <p>In order that the Player's name can be seen from a distance for spectators in the stadium and television viewers, lettering must be a minimum height of 6 centimetres and a maximum height of 10 centimetres.</p> <p>The country name must be a height of 5 centimetres.</p> <p>The sequence on the shirt from top to bottom shall be player name, country name and advert.</p> <p>Note: Clothing regulations will be strictly adhered to at this event. Failure to comply may affect an athlete's eligibility to go on court and compete.</p>
Service Height	<p>Alternative Service Laws as per chapter 4 – section 4.1.4 (link) will apply for standing matches. Service for Wheelchair badminton matches will follow Laws of Badminton, article 9.1.6.1 (link).</p>
Prizes & Awards	<p>Prizes (medals) will be awarded in accordance with PBGCR 3.3.2 No matches will be played to determine 3rd/4th place.</p>
Ceremonies	<p>Players are not allowed to wear hats, caps or flags during the presentation ceremonies. Rackets may not be carried during presentations. Tracksuits, or clothing as worn during play, will be allowed. No other form of advertisement will be permitted.</p> <p>Note: This regulation will be strictly enforced by our stewards prior to each ceremony.</p>
Doping control	<p>Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE) – players who must take medications which contained Prohibited Substances, MUST seek permission to use these substances before they take these. TUE's MUST be approved 21 days before international competition. The forms are available on the BWF website (link)</p> <p>Anti-Doping tests are conducted at international competitions.</p> <p>More information on Anti-Doping can be found at https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/</p>
Shuttles	<p>YONEX AEROSSENSA 50 (BWF approved)</p>
Insurance	<p>Participants must take out and should be covered by their own travel, health and personal accident insurance. The organisers will not be responsible for any medical costs.</p>



Classification

Eligibility

There will be NO classification before the start of competition. BWF Classifiers may however be around to observe the World Championships.

Only players with classification status Confirmed (C) and Fixed Review Date (FRD) with a date after the World Championships can compete.

<p>Practice Facilities</p>	<p>4 wheelchair courts and 4 standing courts will be available at the Competition Venue from Saturday, 17 August until the Para-Badminton World Championships start. Please complete and return the attached form to make a request.</p> <p>The deadline to submit the court reservation form is Friday, 2 August 2019. The organisers will confirm practice times with the teams at a later date.</p>
<p>Massage and Physiotherapy</p>	<p>These will be available for players throughout the tournament during hours of play, free of charge. An appointment system will operate to ensure equal opportunities for all players.</p>
<p>Media</p>	<p>It is a condition of entry that each player must be willing to give interviews for television immediately after a match whether the match has been won or lost.</p>
<p>Photo and video material</p>	<p>BWF has the right to use photographs, film material or any other image of players taken during events sanctioned by BWF.</p> <p>The organizer records all matches and distributes them on a Memory Stick on request.</p>
