Entry fees Single events: 50€ Double: 50€ per player/events

The Member Association that enters a player into a BEC Elite Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and will not be removed until the entry deadline passes. We recommend to pay the entry fees by bank transfer, but the organisers may accept cash payment on spot.

The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member Association.

Entries must be submitted not later than Tuesday 01st October 2019 at 23.59 BWF HQ time. (GMT +08.00)

No late entries will be accepted.

Players can not be entered unless they already have a BWF ID-number. In case you wish to enter players who do not have a BWF ID-number, please contact the BWF office well in advance of the tournament, so that the players concerned can get a BWF ID-number before the closing date of the tournament. Organisers are allowed to refuse entries if players have outstanding fees from a previous year.



It is required that every event in a particular BEC Elite Circuit tournament has at least 8 competitors (i.e. actual competitors, not merely entries). If the required number of competitors is not met, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking, i.e. BEC Elite Circuit Ranking and BWF World Ranking.

In accordance with regulation 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.1: World Ranking System, an event must contain at least one entry from a Member Association other than the hosting Association. If an event does not contain at least one entry from a Member Association other than the hosting Association, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

BADMINTON EUROPE is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

Compliance with GCR 7.9: “In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF’s regulations and Disciplinary processes.”

- Events** Men’s Singles, Women's Singles, Men’s Doubles, Women's Doubles, Mixed Doubles. The number of players/pairs to be accepted for the main events in Singles 32 and in Doubles 24.
- System of the Competition** K.O. system according to the Laws of Badminton and Competition Regulations of the BWF.
- Eligibility** Participation is open to players of any National Association recognised by the BWF.
- Shuttles** YONEX AS 50
- Courts** 5 YONEX courts
- Prize money** US\$ 25.000 (paid in cash). No taxes will be deducted.

Withdrawals	<p>Please ensure that the Organizer must be informed immediately when a player has to withdraw, preferably together with its reason.</p> <p>Attention: Any withdrawal after the Monday immediately preceding the draw, for any reason whatsoever, renders the Member Association concerned liable to an amount of US\$ 150,00 for the inconvenience caused by the withdrawal (as defined in BWF General Competition Regulations).</p> <p>Any player not showing up at the tournament, without having been withdrawn in advance, renders the Member Association concerned liable to an additional amount of US\$ 500,00 for the inconvenience caused by the “no show” (as defined in BWF General Competition Regulations).</p>
Visa	<p>If you need a Hungarian Visa please ask the Hungarian Badminton Association for the official Invitation letter. It is advised to arrange the VISA on time.</p>
Draws	<p>Will be made by the Badminton Europe on 15th October 2019.</p>
Condition of play	<p>The tournament will be played in full accordance with the Laws of Badminton and the Competition Regulations adopted by the BWF as well as the Badminton Europe Elite Circuit Regulation.</p> <p>Competitors must be prepared to play at the times determined for the events for which they have entered. Competitors will be scratched if not ready to play when called.</p>
Accommodation	<p>Holiday Inn Budapest-Budaörs **** H-2040 Budaörs, Agip utca 2. Single room: 80 EURO/night/person Double room: 50 EURO/night/person The price of rooms includes breakfast, free WIFI, free sauna usage and free transport.</p> <p>The hotel booking must be made through the organizers and must be paid to the organizers as well! Payment can be made by bank transfer in advance to the Organizer or can be made by cash during the competition to the Organizer.</p> <p>The hotel must be booked from the Organizer until 07th October 2019 on the attached Accommodation Form. The Organizer cannot guarantee the requested rooms after the reservation's deadline!</p>
Local transport	<p>Provided by the organizer free between the Budapest airport, train stations, the official hotel and the sportshall. The organizer is not able to offer transport for those players and officials who are not staying in the official hotel and for those who do not make their reservation through the organizer! In case of any individual hotel booking made by players/coaches the organizer will not provide for them shuttle bus service!</p> <p>Players shall not plan their departure less than two (2) hours after their last match is planned to conclude. If a player is unable to compete due to early departure, he/she will be penalised by removal of Elite Circuit ranking points and shall not be awarded prizes or prize money. BADMINTON EUROPE shall propose to BWF that the gained BWF ranking points are also removed.</p>
Medical service	<p>Doctor on court / physician will be present in the Sports hall during the tournament.</p>



- Doping control** According to Hungarian Law Drug Testing may be carried out on a random basis at any time. Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.
Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

- Badminton Integrity** Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.
To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.
Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.

- Live Streaming** **There will be live streaming on the center court during the whole tournament.**
- Clothing regulations** Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to BWF.
It is mandatory that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts at all time during play in both the qualification and the main draw. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 100,00 EUR. In applying these regulations, the decision of the Referee shall be final.
- Insurance** The organizer declines responsibility and covering of costs for possible injuries or other damages. It is up to each participant to insure himself.
Member Association and/or Organiser may be liable for claims originating from the damages incurred by the participants and/or any other persons, arising from or in connection to the particular BEC Elite Circuit tournament, according to local Law. BADMINTON EUROPE is not liable for any such claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any nature whatsoever, including but not limited to injury or loss to person or property, arising out of or in any way related, directly or indirectly, to the particular BEC Elite Circuit tournament. It is recommended that Member Associations and/or Organisers purchase a proper Insurance Policy that would cover their potential legal liability.
- Practice** on Tuesday 29th October 2019 in the evening after the court installation; and before the first match and after the last mach on every competition's day. No practice reservation, the courts are free for using.
- Tournament cancellation** The Hungarian Badminton Association can cancel the tournament in case of force majeure 15 days before the start of the tournament. If the tournament is cancelled less than 15 days before the start of the tournament, the Hungarian Badminton Association is liable for any expenses incurred by the players, coaches, umpires, team managers).
