7.0 AGE ELIGIBILITY

- U-19 : All players must be under 19 years old throughout the calendar year of the tournament. i.e. **born on or after 2001.** (Singles, Doubles and Mixed)
- U-17 : All players must be under 17 years old throughout the calendar year of the tournament. i.e. **born on or after 2003.** (Singles, Doubles and Mixed)
- U-15 : All players must be under 15 years old throughout the calendar year of the tournament. i.e. **born on or after 2005.** (Singles and Doubles)
- All players of U-15, U-17 and U-19 **MUST** have a BWF Player's ID before submission of the entries. Players without BWF ID should contact their respective National Association. The National Association is responsible for the creation of New BWF ID's for their members

8.0 ENTRIES TIMELINE AND PROCEDURE

- Entries closing date : **Tuesday, 9th July 2019.**
Hours : 24.00 WIB (West Indonesia Time), GMT +07:00h
- All entries must be submitted through their national associations. Member Associations are advised to log on to online entry system: - <http://bwf.tournamentsoftware.com/sport/tournament.aspx?id=E19D44B2-1C55-4C8E-962B-058D95EDEF3C> to submit the entries.
- You will require a username and password to submit the entries and this can be obtained from Mr. Shanmugam from BWF at s.ramachandran@bwfbadminton.org . The online entry page will close immediately on the entries closing date at 23:59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT) and you are required to submit the entries on time. Late entries will not be accepted.
- After the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries. Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline. The Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by the Tuesday (next day of the entries closing date) by noon BWF Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT) following close of entries. If no objection is received by BWF by Tuesday (second day after the entries closing

day) 23:59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT) following the close of entries, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections shall be entertained after this point.

- Entries for Indonesian players shall be submitted by the club of each participant concerned to : si.pbsi.or.id by Online System (SI PBSI) until **4th July 2019**
- Entries for foreign players must be sent together with the scanning of the passport otherwise they won't be accepted, email to : pbsi.dkijakarta2015@gmail.com

9.0 SCORING SYSTEM

- All events will be played using the best of three games of 21 rally points.
- The tournament will be played in full accordance with the Laws of Badminton and BWF Competition Regulations.

10.0 KEY DATES

Main & Qualifying will be based on the BWF World Ranking: **Tuesday, 9th July 2019**

Seeding will be based on the BWF World Junior Ranking: **Tuesday, 16th July 2019**

Withdrawal:

- Withdrawals must be informed by an e-mail to The Referee as soon as possible.
- Withdrawals prior to the tournament must be accompanied by an appropriate certification.
- Withdrawals without penalty: **Monday, 22nd July 2019**
- Withdrawals with penalty after **Monday, 22nd July 2019**
- Withdrawals after the draw is made due to illness or injury must be supported by a medical certificate.
- Withdrawals after players arrive in venue city, notification of withdrawal must be made by the Team Manager to the Referee in writing.

Draw will be conducted on **Tuesday, 23rd July 2019** by Badminton Asia / PBSI.

16.0 DOPING CONTROL

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

17.0 BADMINTON INTEGRITY

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.

18.0 COMPLIANCE WITH GCR CLAUSE 7.9

GCR 7.9: "In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary Processes."

It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that they apply for their visa in sufficient time.
