<b>Regulation</b>	<p>It is required that every event in a particular Junior Circuit tournament has at least 8 actual competitors, not merely entries. If the required is not present the event shall not count towards any ranking.</p> <p>In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least one entry from a Member Association other than the hosting Association. If an event does not contain at least one entry from a Member Association other than the hosting Association, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.</p>																																																	
<b>Events</b>	Men's and Women's Singles Men's and Women's Doubles Mixed Doubles Entry Limits: MS64, WS64, MD32, WD32, XD48																																																	
<b>Eligible Players</b>	All players of clubs affiliated through their National Associations to the BWF. Competitors can be scratched if not ready to play when called. The seeding's and the draw will be done by Badminton Europe.																																																	
<b>Conditions of play</b>	<p>The tournament will be played in full accordance with the laws of Badminton and Competition Regulations adopted by the BWF as well as the regulations of the Badminton Europe's Circuit.</p> <p>(c)If more players/pairs enter the competition than the Organisers can accept the BWF Junior Ranking shall be used to determine the players/pairs whose entries can be accepted and which entry to fill any subsequent vacancy that may arise. Competitors must be prepared to play at the times quoted in the order of play for the events for which they were entered. Competitors can be scratched if not ready to play when called. Players shall not plan their departure less than two (2) hours after their last match is planned to conclude. <b>*Finals may not conclude until 4 P.M</b></p> <p>A withdrawal (after the entry deadline), a "No Show" or the retirement of a player in any event will cause that player to be withdrawn from all entered events.</p>																																																	

<b>Clothing / Advertising</b>	<p>Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with BEC Junior Circuit Regulation 13</p> <p>13.1 Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations § 12 to 16. A player violating these regulations shall be penalised by an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.</p> <p>13.2 It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.</p>

	<p>The Member Association that enters a player into a Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player.</p> <p>The entry fees must be paid at the same times as the entries are submitted. The entry fees will not be refunded in the event of a withdrawal once the entry deadline has passed.</p> <p>Organisers are allowed to refuse entries if players have outstanding fees from a previous year.</p>
<b>Visas</b>	<p>After entering player(s) in the tournament it is the Member Association's responsibility to secure visas for their players – if this is needed. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

### **Badminton Integrity**

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.

### **Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9**

*GCR 7.9: "In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."*
