It is mandatory to have an eVisa before your travel.</p> <p><b>25.3. All other nationalities must apply for a visa through any of the channels below</b></p> <p>25.3.1. <b>Recommendation:</b> - Contingents who require a visa for entry into UAE must furnish their personal details in the enclosed format to enable the Official Travel Agents to process the visa. The cost of processing visa is USD 100/- per applicant, which must be paid to the agent via bank transfer, as per the details in the invoice (will be sent once you submit the Visa Request Form). It is located on the southeast coast of the Persian Gulf and is the capital of the Emirate of Dubai, one of the seven emirates that make up the country.</p> <p><b>Dress code:</b> The UAE has a modest dress code, which is part of Dubai's criminal law. Most malls in the UAE have a dress code displayed at entrances. At Dubai's malls, females should cover their shoulders and knees; therefore, women are not permitted to wear sleeveless tops. However, people can wear swimwear at the pools and beaches.</p> <p><b>Religion:</b> Islam is the official religion in the UAE; the practice of other religions is allowed.</p> <p><b>Language:</b> The official language of the UAE is Arabic. Other widely spoken languages include Bengali, English, Farsi, Hindi, Malayalam, Mandarin, Nepali, Russian, Sinhalese, Tagalog &amp; Urdu.</p> <p><b>Time:</b> The UAE is 4 hours ahead of GMT.</p> <p><b>Climate:</b> The UAE maintains a desert climate. It is warm and sunny in the winter, and during the summer, it is hot and humid.</p> <p>During September, the average temperature is 34<sup>°C</sup> (39<sup>°C</sup> to 28<sup>°C</sup> max-min).</p> <p><b>Currency:</b> The Emirati Dirham is the official currency of the UAE, abbreviated officially as AED. The UAE Dirham is pegged to the USD. 1 USD = AED 3.6725</p> <p><b>Working days:</b> Government and semi-government offices operate from Sunday to Thursday.</p> <p><b>Airports:</b> Dubai has two airports viz. <a href="#">Dubai International Airport</a> (IATA code: DXB) and <a href="#">Al Maktoum Airport</a> (IATA code: DWC). The DXB is at the heart of the city and close to the official hotel and the</p>
