MANDATORY CLOTHING REGULATIONS

1. Name of player is MANDATORY from the first day of the event.
2. Colour clothing of the pair must be the same from Quarter Finals onwards.
3. Opposing player/pair must wear significantly different colours from Quarter Finals onwards.

◆The regulations are not strictly applied for the other age groups except for Advertising regulation.

* As It will be cold weather in December during events, kindly bring along the appropriate clothes for winter.

23. Doping Control:

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

24. Badminton Integrity:

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed

to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.

25. Compliance with GCR 7.9:

GCR 7.9: "In making or authorizing entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary Processes."
