WITHDRAWALS	<p>Withdrawal of players without penalty is <b>Monday 14 October 2019</b>. Players withdrawing after <b>Monday 14 October 2019</b> or no-show will have to pay a fine of US\$ 150 and US\$ 500 respectively.</p>
MEDICAL	<p>The organisers will provide for a doctor, physiotherapists and other support medical staff at all times in the hall for the duration of the tournament.</p>
INSURANCE	<p>Participants must arrange their own insurance for health, travel and property. The organisers will not be responsible for any medical costs.</p>
DOPING CONTROL	<p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.</p> <p>Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. <p style="text-align: center;"><b>CONDITIONS</b></p>	<p>The tournament will be played on a knock-out system and in full accordance with the General Competition Regulations of the BWF and the instructions of Badminton Confederation Africa. Competitors must be prepared to play at the times determined for the events for which they have entered.</p> <p>Players shall not plan their departure less than four (4) hours after their last match is a plan to conclude. Such a player/pair shall lose all the ranking points gained and Badminton Confederation Africa shall propose to BWF that the gained BWF ranking points are removed.</p> <p>According to the BWF General Competition Regulations, there are no world ranking points for an International with less than 8 entries in (MS, WS, MD, WD and XD). In such a case, the tournament may be cancelled and the organisers will not take any responsibility for any arrangements that may have been already made.</p>
