9. Event: Team competition: Each tie shall be decided by the result of three doubles matches
10. Rules: Tournament will be played in accordance with BWF Laws of Badminton, General Competition Regulations, Recommendations to Technical Officials and JLBF Competition Regulations.
11. Constitution of Teams
 - (1) Each team is to be comprised of 6-8 players, plus a team manager, and a coach, for a total of 10
(Players may also act as coach and / or manager.)
(Players only female, no matter sex of the coach and the manager)
A team with less than 6 players attending at the match starting time will be disqualified.
 - (2) A group: Teams of higher levels.
B group: The total age of 6 players(3 doubles) is under 271.
C group: The total age of 6 players(3 doubles) is from 271 to 300 .
D group: The total age of 6 players(3 doubles) is from 301 to 319
E group: The total age of 6 players(3 doubles) is 320 and over
F group: Age of all players of the team is 55 and over (born before 1964).
G group: Age of all players of the team is 60 and over (born before 1959).
H group: Age of all players of the team is 65 and over (born before 1954).
J group: Age of all players of the team is 70 and over (born before 1949).
K group: Age of all players of the team is 75 and over (born before 1944).
The age is based on December 31, 2019
 - (3) Any change of players after entry should be notified to the office by October 16 (Wed), 2019
 - (4) Japanese players living in Japan must be members of Japan Ladies Badminton Federation.
(B-K group)
12. Method of competition:
 - (1) Group Stage; Round Robin within groups (each group consists of four to five teams).
 - (2) Knock Out Stage;The winning team (or the second-placed team in some cases) from each group will play on a knock out basis.
 - (3) The point limit set for the matches depends on the number of participating teams.
 - (4) Every player must not play in more than one doubles match for each tie.

13. Shuttles : YONEX (TOURNAMNET, NEW OFFICIAL)

14. Qualifications:

Female Aged 18 and over. (born before 2001)

Players should bring a passport (copy)

15. Award: (1) A Group: Winners: JPY300,000, Medals, Runners-up: JPY200,000, 3rd place JPY150,000 and certificates of merit will be also awarded.

(2) B-J Group: Winners, Runners-up, and 3rd place finishers will receive certificates of merit and the extra prize.

(3) All players will receive a token of participation.

16. Entry Fee : JPY30,000. Payment methods will be announced when the entry form will be received.
