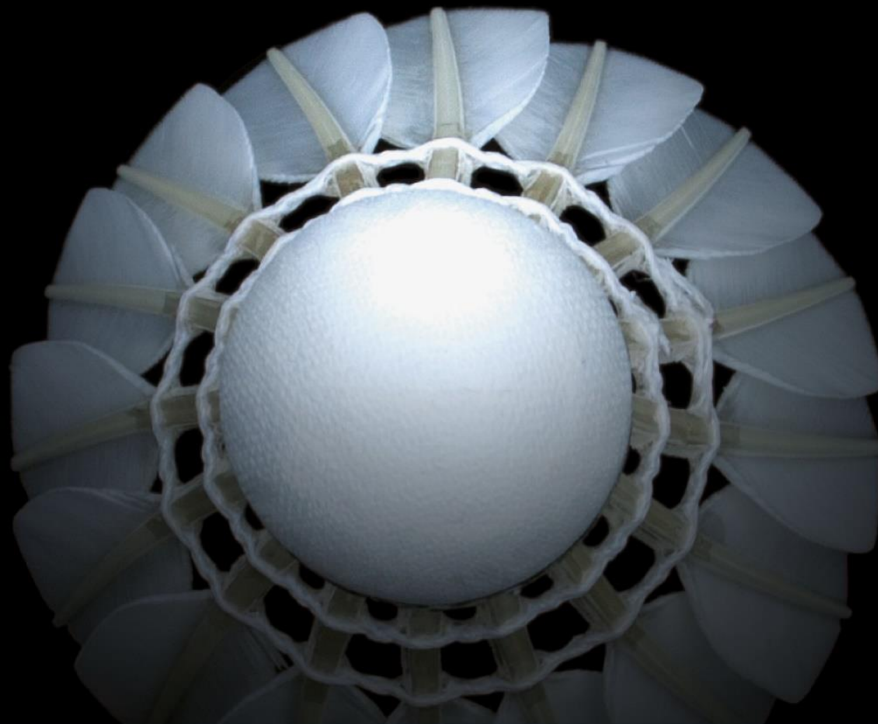

In despite of the situation we are still trying to organize the best possible tournament for the players so that they can all focus on what they like: the game!

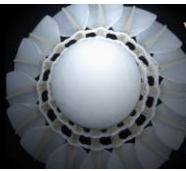

Such insurance shall cover bodily injury, including medical and hospitalisation expenses incurred in the host country, as well as all expenses and costs associated to repatriating the injured party to its country of residence.
<b>Indemnity</b>	To the extent permitted by applicable law, all players and members of the national delegation shall release the BWF, the Tournament Organiser, and their respective officers, officials, employees, agents and representatives, from any and all liability, damage, loss, cost or expense that such players and members of the national delegation may incur as a result or in connection with their participation to the Tournament.
<b>Participant Agreement for Use of Photographs and Videos</b>	Players and all members of the national delegation shall agree to give the BWF and the Tournament Organiser full television and motion picture rights, including permission to film players and members of the national delegation during all matches and activities around the Tournament, for any commercial, news or other purpose together with the right to transfer such right, including without compensation.

<b>Regulations (Conditions of Play)</b>	<p>This tournament will be run in accordance with, but not limited to, the Badminton World Federation (BWF) Statutes, General Competition Regulations (GCR), and BWF World Tour Regulations. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final.</p> <p>This tournament will strictly enforce the Clothing, Equipment, and Advertising Regulations as outlined in the BWF GCR 20 – 24. This includes restrictions of certain colours for shirts, shorts, and skirts to avoid issues with virtual advertising on TV courts, as per GCR 21.7.</p>														
<b>Scoring System</b>	Best of three games to 21 points, as per the Laws of Badminton (BWF Statute 4.1)														
<b>Instant Review System</b>	The Instant Review System (IRS) will available on Court 1, and is regulated as per BWF Statute 4.1.8.

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The entry deadline is Tuesday, 26 January 2021 at 23:59, BWF Headquarters time (+08:00 hrs GMT). Late entries will not be accepted.

After the entry deadline, the BWF Online Group Entry System will send notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries.

Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline.

Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by Wednesday, 27 January 2021 at 12:00 hrs BWF Headquarters time.

If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday, 28 January 2021 at 23:59 hrs BWF Headquarters time, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections will be entertained after this point.

## Online Entry – Hosting Member Association Entries

Eligible player wishing to enter through the hosting Member Association must follow a different process to international entries.

## Withdrawals

The management of withdrawals will be run in accordance with BWF GCR 13 and 14.

Member Associations can withdraw their entries through the BWF Online Group Entry system until the last date of withdrawal without penalty (see Key Dates Section).

Withdrawals made after this date will incur a penalty in accordance with the BWF Table of Offences and Penalties (BWF Statute 2.5).

Please ensure that the Tournament Referee and Host Organiser are notified immediately in writing, clearly stating the reason for the withdrawal.

If a Member Association needs to withdraw any entries once players have arrived in the host city, notification of withdrawal must be made by the Team Manager in person to the Tournament Referee, or Deputy Referee(s), and must also be confirmed in writing to:

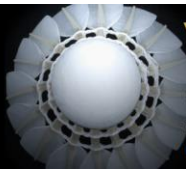

## Presentation Ceremonies

All prize ceremonies will take place on Sunday, 07 March 2021, immediately after the conclusion of each final. Medals/trophies/other will be presented to all champions and finalists.

In accordance with Player Commitment Regulations (BWF Statue 5.3.6), all players participating in the finals of a tournament must attend the final ceremonies directly after the match or must follow the instructions given by the organisers regarding ceremony protocol.

No equipment, including rackets and flags, are allowed to be brought onto the podium. Clothing worn during the ceremony must be in accordance with the BWF GCR.

## Accreditation

Access to Tournament venues and other services is provided through personalized and photographic accreditation.

Accreditation will only be issued after a player/entourage/official:

- a) Submit a **pre-arrival** negative test certificate to Swiss Badminton with the test dated 26 February, 27 February or 28 February. This includes players living in Switzerland. Please send the test certificate to [registration@swissopen.com](mailto:registration@swissopen.com)
- b) Test negative for COVID-19 upon arrival

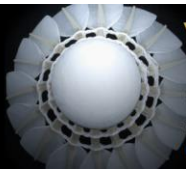
The number of complimentary accreditation passes available for Team Officials is dependent on the number of competing player from the same Member Association:

A limited number of additional accreditation passes for approved Team Officials will be available for purchase at a fee of USD\$150, charged to the respective Member Association, and payable at the tournament.

The fee to replace any lost or damaged accreditation passes will be USD\$100 on each occasion, charged to the respective Member Association.

	<p>The tournament reserves the right to refuse entry into any accredited venue or area or service (e.g. transportation) as a result of damaged or missing accreditation or if a player/official/volunteer/staff refuse to take a COVID-19 test when requested or if there is a serious breach of COVID-19 safety measures or any other breach of regulations.</p> <p>The fraudulent use of accreditation is strictly prohibited, and will result in access rights being removed, and penalties being applied.</p>
<p><b>Medical Services</b></p>	<p>A physiotherapist service will be available during the tournament, free of charge to players.</p>
<p><b>Anti-Doping</b></p>	<p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.</p> <p>Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. 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## 4. Travel & Visa Details

### Transport

Due to COVID-19 testing arrival is allowed only on Sunday 28th February or Monday 1<sup>st</sup> March (18:00 latest).

Arrival is allowed only with a negative PCR test (not older than 72 hours) in English.

Complimentary transportation will be provided by the tournament between the official venues: competition venue, official hotel(s), and the following transportation hubs:

- EuroAirport Basel-Mulhouse-Freiburg
- Basel Railway Station SBB
- Basel Badischer Bahnhof

To request transportation, please complete and return the Transportation Request Form by 18 February 2021.

Transportation is organized on a regular basis between the hall and the official hotels. For questions, please reach out to / ask for David at the transportation desk.

Please be aware that the shuttle times between the hall and the hotels will take about 30min.

Team Managers are requested to organise their transportation early enough with our transport manager David Hess at the transport desk during the tournament.

### Visas

If a visa is required to enter Switzerland, we can provide a letter of invitation to assist with your application.

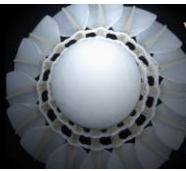

The tournament host and hosting Member Association will only communicate with a Member Association, and the hosting Member Association will only provide a visa support letter if all required information is provided.

The tournament host and hosting Member Association accepts no responsibility for withdrawals made due to late or refused visa applications.

It is the responsibility of the Member Association to apply for the necessary visas in sufficient time, and all matters should be directed to the Embassy in charge.

Any visa support letter issued by the tournament host does not guarantee entry into Switzerland; the final decision is made by the Government of Switzerland.



## COVID-19 Protocols

### 1. Switzerland Entry Requirements

As of 7 January 2021 citizens from EU and Schengen countries do not currently have any entry restrictions into Switzerland. Citizens from all other countries should check the below link for the latest regulations. In most cases citizens of third countries will need a visa to enter Switzerland, please see visa requirements section for more information.

### 2. Quarantine

As of 7 January 2021 arrivals into Switzerland from a few countries are legally mandated to undertake a 10 day quarantine period. Swiss Badminton have arranged a quarantine exemption for players travelling from these countries. The countries list is subject to change and can be viewed below. At present it has not been possible to obtain an exemption for UK and South Africa participants however we are hopeful this will change in the coming weeks. The prospectus will be updated as and when any new information is available.

### 3. Insurance

Specific COVID-19 insurance is not currently required to enter Switzerland however all participants must have personal insurance covering any situation included Covid-19 hospitalization, quarantine and any other costs. The Local Organising Committee is not responsible for any insurance costs related to COVID-19 during the tournament.

### 4. Hotels

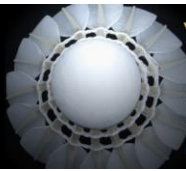
It is a condition of entry that all participants must stay in the official hotels listed below.

### 5. COVID-19 testing

The COVID-19 testing programme will be carried out as follows:

All players and team entourage must submit a **pre-arrival** negative Covid-19 PCR test certificate to Swiss Badminton with the test dated as 26 February, 27 February or 28 February 2021. This includes players living in Switzerland. Please send the test certificate to [registration@swissopen.com](mailto:registration@swissopen.com)

- On arrival to Basel an **arrival** Covid-19 PCR test will be carried out. Players and entourage are not permitted to leave their hotel rooms until a negative result has been obtained



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(up to 24 hours).

- On Friday 5 March all players and entourage will be tested again to ensure the Green Zone is continuously free from infection. Players do not need to quarantine whilst waiting for the results.

In the event of a positive test the participant is required to follow the instructions of the LOC, BWF and the local authorities at all times.

More information will be distributed before the tournament.
