

If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.</p> <p>In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member</p>

Entry Fees:	<p>Singles: 30€ per player Doubles: 25€ per player</p> <p>The entry fees must be paid on arrival.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Everyone who wants to pay in advance by bank transfer has to send an email accordingly (events@badminton.gr) in order to receive the invoice and the bank account. Entry fee must be paid before a player's first scheduled match. - The Member that enters a player into a BEC Junior Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player.
Withdrawals:	<p>The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes.</p> <p>The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of withdrawal after the entry deadline. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.</p>
Badminton Integrity	<p>Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anticorruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament. To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match. Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches. Doping Control:	<p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF AntiDoping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). 	According to Greek Legislation, Drug Testing may be carried out on a random basis throughout the tournament.
Insurance:	The Organizers decline responsibility and covering of costs for possible injuries or other damages. It is up to participants to insure themselves.
Imaging Permissions:	When a player is entered in a BWF-sanctioned event, television- broadcasting and still photography of that event is permitted at all associated venues (including training/practice) without further need to seek the consent of the player of Member concerned. Television signals can be shown in any and all territories on live or recorded television, internet, webcasting, audio, film and other media of similar nature
Clothing/ Advertising:	13.1 Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations § 12 to 16. A player violating these regulations shall be penalised by an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR. 13.2 It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR. In order to ensure an attractive presentation of badminton, only acceptable badminton sports clothing will be permitted during play. The Referee is instructed to pay particular attention to uphold these regulations on clothing. In applying regulations on clothing and designs and advertising on players' clothing the decision of the Referee shall be final.
Medical Service:	A doctor will be present in the hall during the tournament.
Cancellation of the tournament:	The organising Member can cancel a tournament in case of force majeure.

Visas:	After entering player(s) in the tournament it is the Member's responsibility to secure visas for their players – if this is needed. The Tournament Organisers will do everything possible to enable the entered players to get a visa. For assistance to the organisers of the visa paperwork, no later than June 30, 2021. The following information regarding the foreigner being invited shall be given: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • name (-s) and surname; • citizenship (nationality); • date and place of birth; • the address of the place of residence; • the location (office) where the visa application will likely be submitted • valid passport details Information should be sent to events@badminton.gr
