<p><b>Eligibility</b></p>	<p>The tournament will be played in full accordance to the Laws of Badminton and General Competition Regulations adopted by the BWF and Badminton Europe Junior Circuit Regulations. Participation in the Spanish Junior International is open to players of any National Association recognized by the BWF and any currently registered members of the Spanish Badminton Federation</p>
<p><b>Entries</b></p>	<p>BWF Online Entry system. Entries must be made directly by a Member of which the player/pair is a member <a href="https://bwf.tournamentsoftware.com/sport/tournament?id=C64E47ED-D60E-4683-8A0F-94983FA6B2B5">https://bwf.tournamentsoftware.com/sport/tournament?id=C64E47ED-D60E-4683-8A0F-94983FA6B2B5</a></p> <p>Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9 GCR 7.9: "In making or authorizing entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."</p> <p>In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.</p> <p>In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.</p> <p>BADMINTON EUROPE is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.</p>



<p><b>Entry Fees</b></p>	<p>25 EUROS per player in singles. 20 EUROS per player in doubles. (40 EUROS per combination in doubles)</p> <p>The Member that enters a player/pair into a BEC Junior Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. <p><b>Draw</b></p>	<p>According with BEC Junior Circuit Regulations, BADMINTON EUROPE will make the draw. Draw will be made on Tuesday 25th May 2021</p>
<p><b>Advertising Clothing</b></p>	<p>13.1 Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations § 12 to 16. A player violating these regulations shall be penalised by an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.</p> <p>13.2 It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.</p> <p>In order to ensure an attractive presentation of badminton, only acceptable badminton sports clothing will be permitted during play. The Referee is instructed to pay particular attention to uphold these regulations on clothing. In applying regulations on clothing and designs and advertising on players' clothing the decision of the Referee shall be final.</p>
<p><b>Insurance</b></p>	<p>The Organizers decline responsibility and covering of costs for possible injuries or other damages. It is up to participants to insure themselves.</p>
<p><b>Medical</b></p>	<p>A doctor will be present in the sports hall during the Tournament.</p>
<p><b>Visas</b></p>	<p>After entering a player(s) in the tournament it is the Member 's responsibility to secure visas for their players – if this is needed; Members must make sure that visa applications are made early enough; Badminton Association of Spain will provide Official Invitation Letter – if this is needed. 	<p><b><u>Doping Control</u></b> Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches. <p><b>COVID-19 Protocols</b></p>	<p><b><u>1. Spain Entry Requirements</u></b></p> <p>1.1. All information about the current requirements to entry to Spain is available here: <a href="https://www.spth.gob.es">https://www.spth.gob.es</a></p> <p><i>What do I have to bring with me to pass the sanitary control at the airport? Before traveling to Spain, make sure you have signed the form, on the web <a href="https://www.spth.gob.es">spth.gob.es</a> or in our mobile app. With this you will get the Health QR Code that you will have to show (paper or mobile) at the airport health control to be able to continue your trip. If you sign the form from the app, it will appear in the 'My Travel' section, in addition to receiving an email that you can print.</i></p> <p><i>All players and team entourage must submit a pre-arrival negative Covid-19 PCR test 72 hours before their arrival to Spain to the following e-mail: <a href="mailto:SpanishInternationalU19@badminton.es">SpanishInternationalU19@badminton.es</a>. This includes players living in Spain. It is recommended to keep a physical copy of the certificate in case it is needed at the airport or arrival point.</i></p> <p>2.2. Countries that are not allowed to enter to Spain As of 1 March 2021 people travelling on flights and ships from the UK, Portugal, South Africa and Brazil are not permitted to enter Spain. The tournament website will be updated as and when new information is available.</p> <p>2.3. All participants travelling from outside Schengen Area needs a certificate from the Host to travel to Spain, so each team must fill and send, in advance, the attached applicant form with their names, surnames, passport ID and travelling dates (arrival and departure). Deadline for sending this information May 14th.</p>



	<p><b><u>2. Insurance</u></b></p> <p>Specific COVID-19 insurance is not currently required to enter Spain. However, all participants must have personal insurance covering any situation included Covid-19 hospitalization, quarantine and any other costs. The Local Organising Committee is not responsible for any insurance costs related to COVID-19 during the tournament.</p> <p><b><u>3.
