The competition will be organised and run-in accordance with the Classification Regulations, Para Badminton General Competition Regulations, General Competition Regulations and Laws of Badminton. Minimum Entries	If entries are not sufficient for a group draw followed by a knock-out draw, a single group format shall apply.
Combinations	If there are less than four (4) entries or less than two (2) represented countries in a particular event, the events may be combined in accordance with the Para Badminton Competition Regulation 9.1.5 – see www.bwfbadminton.com
Withdrawals	<p>All withdrawals notification should be sent to the BWF, Referee, TD and Tournament Organiser in writing as soon as possible – at least 14 days before first competition day (by 11:59 PM Kuala Lumpur time). Conditions of play	The tournament will be played in accordance with BWF Laws of Badminton, Para Badminton General Competition Regulations and General Competition Regulations, – see the BWF website https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/statutes/
Readiness to Play	All events will be run on a strict time scale. <u>Competitors must be ready to play 30 minutes before the scheduled match time.</u> If players are not ready to play at the scheduled time they will be disqualified. Any changes to the schedule of play will be announced by the Referee.
Warm-up / practice	On court, warm up time is limited to a maximum of 2 minutes.
Entry	Entries can only be accepted on the Official Entry Form.
Modifications	In case of modifications or to give the Organisers additional information - write these on the Official Entry Form and resend this by email.
Acceptance of entries	Entries can only be accepted from BWF Members and a national or regional Para Badminton organisation recognised by the BWF.
Request for Partner	A registration for doubles can only be accepted with the name of the partner / pair or with “partner wanted” on the form if a partner is being requested. Any mix nationality pairings, must be entered and approved by both represented countries. If confirmation is not received by both countries, the entry will not be accepted
Clothing & Advertising	See clothing Regulations Para-Badminton General Competition Regulations 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 Note: Clothing regulations should be adhered at this event. Failure to comply may affect an athlete’s eligibility to go on court and compete.
Awards	No matches will be played to determine 3rd/4th place.
Prizes	Prizes (medals) will be awarded in accordance with PBGCR 3.3.2
Doping control	Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE) – players who must take medications which contained Prohibited Substances, MUST seek permission to use these substances before they take these. TUE’s MUST be approved 21 days before international competition. The forms are available on the BWF website (link) Anti-Doping tests are conducted at international competitions. COVID-19	BWF Statutes, Section 2.5.1 – Special Table of Offences and Penalties Relating to breaches of COVID 19 Safety Protocols applies to this tournament.
	Below are general COVID-19 safety protocols that applies to the tournament. The BWF and the LOC will provide more details before the tournament that may include movement restrictions during the tournament.
	Please be aware that the tournament takes place during the current pandemic situation with COVID-19. The conditions for hosting the tournament, as well as hygiene, sanitary and preventive measures will be those determined by the local authorities and BWF at all times. All participants are required to follow the rules and guidelines of the BWF, LOC and local authorities as a condition for participating in the tournament. If the local authorities require it, each participant may have to deliver a responsible declaration before participating in the tournament.
	Should the event be cancelled with short notice by the country’s authorities, due to the COVID-19 situation, beyond the control of both Badminton World Federation and the local organisers, neither of them will be liable for any costs related to travelling or accommodation made by players/officials for this event. Each member must ensure that it is allowed to enter Dubai in the current circumstances. It is strongly recommended that all participants book flight tickets with a cancellation insurance.
	Covid19 rules and regulations according to Dubai sports council-UA:
	These rules applies only in Dubai which mean all teams MUST come through Dubai airport to avoid any complication of quarantine in another state.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All team delegations must provide PCR negative test not older than 72 hours at the departure airport, before arriving to Dubai airport. • All team delegations will be tested free of charge (PCR test) at the arrival terminal in Dubai airport by Dubai health authority and transportation will be available from airport to hotel, they must stay at their hotel room until we receive negative results (LOC expects test results within 24 hours). • Positive cases will be moved to quarantine complex and it will be medically managed by Dubai health authority. • Participants that were in close contact with a positive covid19 case will be retested. Their status of participation in the tournament to be determined after consultation with the BWF, LOC and health authorities. • Body temperature test at the accommodation and competition venue. • Covid-19 precaution procedures will be applied in hotel and competition venue • Covid-19 physician will be designated for ensure safety and prevention. • Day five from arrival PCR covid19 test will be repeated to all Participants and paid by LOC. • Isolation room will be available in hotel and competition venue. • All club facilities and transportations will be sanitized regularly. • Face mask are mandatory all the times except when players are competing on court. • All travelers from Dubai airport should present negative PCR covid19 test not older than 72 hours before flight time. • Local organizing committee are not responsible for any cost resulting from positive cases such as changing flight or hotel accommodation, or quarantine. • All participants should fill the consent form for participation in competition and send it back to the organizing committee. • All participants should adhere to UAE Health Authority law in covid19 prevention rules and regulations to avoid legal consequences. <p>You may refer to the Emirates website (if you are flying with the airline) http: www.emirates.com/English/help/covid-19/</p>
