<p>Eligibility</p>	<p>*Under 19* All players must be under 19 years old throughout the calendar year of the tournament. i.e. born on or after 1st January 2004. The minimum age for all players shall be 12 years old, i.e. born on or before 31st December 2010.</p> <p>All players MUST have a BWF Player's ID before submission of the entries.</p> <p>Players without a BWF ID must contact their National Association Accordingly.</p>

<p>Competition Rules & Regulation</p>	<p>Relevant Badminton World Federation Regulations shall be applicable to this competition.</p>
<p>Clothing & Advertising</p>	<p>Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with the competition regulations of Badminton World Federation. (GCR 20 - 24)</p> <p>The player's name on the back of clothing shall be identical with the name registered as the Last Name (or an abbreviation thereof) in the BWF Player database. Last Name is defined as the family name, surname or similar name under the respective naming protocol of the Member count. (GCR 23.3)</p> <p><u>MANDATORY CLOTHING REGULATIONS</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Name of player is MANDATORY from the first day of the event. 2. From Quarter Finals onwards, doubles partners must wear clothing of the same color. 3. From Quarter Finals onwards, opposing players must wear clothing of significantly different colors.
<p>On Court Doctor</p>	<p>On Court Doctor will be on duty throughout the competition at the tournament Venue.</p>
<p>Doping Control</p>	<p>Doping Test may be conducted randomly throughout the tournament. Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.</p> <p>Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. <p>Badminton Integrity</p>	<p>Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.</p> <p>To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.</p> <p>Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.</p>

COVID 19 Protocols	<p>RESTRICTIONS & COVID PROTOCOL:</p> <p><i>IMPORTANT Note: Covid-19 protocols for this tournament may be subject to change time to time based on the latest Iran’s immigration, border entry and control policies. Any such changes or amendment will be communicated to all participants (via their respective Member Associations).</i></p> <p>General Instructions:</p> <p>1. Iran entry requirements:</p> <p>ONLY Fully Vaccinated Players and Officials, with Vaccination Record Card, are allowed to enter Iran.</p> <p>Passengers entering or transiting through Iran must have a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test taken at most 48 hours before departure from the first embarkation point. The test must be in English.</p> <p>Passengers should fill the Traveler’s Health Declaration before arrival</p> <p>3. Those who need PCR tests to return to their respective countries can arrange it with the organization during the event (payment will be the person's full responsibility).</p> <p>4. Penalties: BWF Statutes, Section 2.5.1 – Special Table of Offences and Penalties Relating to breaches of COVID 19 Safety Protocols applies to this tournament.</p> <p>5. General instructions: Below are general COVID-19 safety protocols that applies to the tournament. The BWF, Badminton Asia and/ or the LOC will provide more details before the tournament that may include movement restrictions during the tournament.</p> <p>Please be aware that the tournament takes place during the current pandemic situation with COVID-19. The conditions for hosting the tournament, as well as hygiene, sanitary and preventive measures will be those determined by the local authorities and BWF at all times.</p> <p>All participants are required to follow the rules and guidelines of the BWF, LOC and local authorities as a condition for participating in the tournament.
