In case you wish to enter players who do not have a BWF ID-number, please contact the BWF office well in advance of the tournament, so that the players concerned can get a BWF ID-number before the closing date of the tournament.</p> <p>Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9</p> <p>GCR 7.9: "In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."</p>																																																	

<p>Entry fee</p>	<p>Singles: € 35 per player. Doubles: € 25 per player, per event.</p> <p>Payment must be done in cash. We accept NIS, Euro or USD currencies.</p> <p>The Member that enters a player/pair into a BEC Junior Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline (22/02/2022) passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but the organizers can accept cash payments at tournaments.</p> <p>The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organizers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.</p>

<p>Doping Control</p>	<p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.</p> <p>Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Fill out the entry statement form within 48 hours prior to departure to Israel https://corona.health.gov.il/en/flights/ 3. Take with you your Certificate of vaccination/recovery. <p>At the airport in Israel:</p>

	<p>1. Take a PCR test. To save 35 NIS of the costs, please pay in advance</p> <p>2. Those vaccinated with Sputnik vaccine will also take a serologic test.</p> <p>After leaving the airport you are required for isolation duration of 24 hours or until you receive a negative results on the PCR test you have taken upon arrival in the airport in Israel, whichever is earlier.</p> <p>Cancellation:</p> <p>Should the event be cancelled with short notice by the Israeli authorities, due to the COVID-19 situation, beyond the control of both the organizers and Badminton Europe, neither of them will be liable for any costs related to traveling or accommodation made by players/officials for this event.</p> <p>Tournament guidelines:</p> <p>Will be published in the tournament website http://badminton-israel.co.il/?page_id=951</p>
