

Here are the new international travel regulations according to the Circular Letter of the COVID-19 Task Force Number 17 of 2022 concerning Health Protocol for International Travel during the COVID-19 Pandemic

### **Requirements to Enter Indonesia:**

1. Comply with the provisions of the health protocol set by the Government;
  - (1) Wearing 3 ply of fabric mask or medical grade mask, covering nose, mouth and chin, anytime, anywhere especially in a public area.
  - (2) Replacing the mask regularly within every 4 (four) hours and dispose the waste in the proper place/bin.
  - (3) Wash your hand regularly with water and a hand soap or hand sanitizer, especially after touching a stuff/thing that has been touch by other person.
  - (4) Maintaining social distance for a minimum of 1.5 meter and avoiding crowds.
  - (5) Do not talk each other and/or taking a phone call inside a public transportation.
  - (6) Do not eat/drink anytime inside a public transportation.
2. Have downloaded [PeduliLindungi](#) app and filled out the Indonesian [e-HAC](#);
3. Have a Valid Visa to entry Indonesia, *visa requirement will be detailed on the below page*;
4. Present the card or certificate (physical or digital) of receiving a complete dose of COVID-19 vaccine (at least 2 dose, only Janssen / J&J Vaccine allows to be only 1 dose as per legal regulation), which is administered at least 14 (fourteen) days before departure as a requirement for entering Indonesia, must be written in English other than the language of the country/region of origin of arrival. The proof should also be [verified](#) on the website of the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Indonesia or e-HAC International Indonesia: <https://vaksinln.dto.kemkes.go.id/sign/in> ;
5. Show negative RT-PCR test results in the country/region of origin which samples are taken within a maximum period of 2 x 24 hours before the departure time and attached at the time of the health examination or Indonesian International e-HAC;
6. Show proof of ownership of health insurance with a minimum coverage value of USD 50,000 which includes financing for handling COVID-19 and medical evacuation to a referral hospital with a minimum coverage value as determined by the organizer, manager or local government authorities;

7. Upon arrival at the entry points, International travellers must undergo a COVID-19 symptom check, including a body temperature check, with the following conditions:

**A. If there is a symptom of COVID-19 or body temperature above 37.5 degrees Celsius: must undergo RT-PCR examination upon arrival** with payment borne by the government for Indonesian citizen and by self-financing for foreign nationals

**B. If there is NO symptom of COVID-19 and body temperature is below 37.5 degrees Celsius: no need to undergo RT-PCR examination upon arrival** and continue their travel with these requirements below :

1) For international travellers who have not yet received vaccination or have received the 1st dose of COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 (fourteen) days before departure must undergo 5 x 24 hours quarantine with mandatory RT-PCR test on day 4;

2) For international travellers who have received the 2nd or 3rd dose of COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 (fourteen) days before departure are allowed to resume their travel;

3) For international travellers under 18 years of age and require special protection, the duration of quarantine follows the provisions imposed on their parents or caregivers/travel companions;

4) For international travellers with special health conditions or comorbid diseases that cause travellers cannot receive vaccines, with the requirements of presenting a doctor's certificate from the State Departure Hospital which states that the concerned person has not been and/or cannot receive COVID-19 vaccination.

8. After RT-PCR sampling upon arrival (for those who requires on point 7.A), the international travellers may continue with:

- a. Inspection of immigration documents and customs documents;
- b. Baggage collection and baggage disinfection;
- c. Pick up an drop off directly to the hotel (your ground transportation), lodging accommodation or place of residence;
- d. Waiting for the results of the RT-PCR examination in hotel rooms;
- e. It is not allowed to leave the hotel room or accommodation room before the RT-PCR test results show a negative result.
- f. In the event of RT-PCR tests show negative results, Indonesian citizens and foreign nationals are allowed to continue the journey and will be recommended to

conduct an independent health monitoring for 14 days and must follow health protocol

9. In the event that the results of the RT-PCR examination (if required) upon arrival at the entry point shows a positive result, then it will be followed up with the following provisions:
  - a) If asymptomatic or experiencing mild symptoms, isolation or treatment is carried out in isolation hotels or centralized isolation facilities set by the government for 5 (five) days; or
  - b) If accompanied by moderate or severe symptoms, and/or with uncontrolled comorbidities, isolation or treatment at a COVID-19 referral hospital is carried out for 14 (fourteen) days;
  - c) The cost of isolation/treatment for foreigners is borne independently.
10. As of now until further notice, Indonesian government applied a quarantine-free trial period for all foreigners or Indonesian citizens arriving from abroad. If the foreign traveller is **double** vaccinated or has received a **booster** jab and also doesn't show any COVID-19 symptoms on arrival, then they do not require quarantine. However, they must follow health protocols
11. For International travellers/foreigners with special health conditions or comorbid diseases that cause travellers cannot receive vaccines, with the requirements of **presenting a doctor's certificate / official letter from the State Departure Hospital which states that the concerned person has not been and/or cannot receive COVID-19 vaccination**. The foreigners has to bring the letter upon arrival in Indonesia and shows to the health screen team at the airport. Upon arrival, they must undergo a COVID-19 symptom check, including a body temperature check (*Point 7*).

## Additional Information:

### **COVID-19 Vaccination Registration (Updated)**

The Government of Indonesia will require international travellers who have received COVID-19 vaccination overseas to register their COVID-19 vaccination [here](https://vaksinln.dto.kemkes.go.id/sign/in) (<https://vaksinln.dto.kemkes.go.id/sign/in>) The registration will allow you to dine-in or enter public premises and travel with public transport (inter or intra islands) in Indonesia.

You need to make an account and register your vaccination on the link. The verification email will normally be sent out between 3 – 10 business days. Please expect delays as the central server in Jakarta, Indonesia has received large volume of registration requests recently. All international travellers **may still be able to enter Indonesia without the COVID-19 registration**. If you are foreign citizen, you will have to input your Passport information to the website. The COVAX (COVID-19 Vaccination Card) record will be verified by respective embassy in Jakarta. Please consult with your respective Embassy for more information.

Upon receipt the verification email, please download "Peduli Lindungi" application on your Apple Store or Google Play. Upon logged-in, go to "Vaccine Certificate" and click "Claim Now". Follow the instructions to claim your vaccination certificate. The certificate will have a unique barcode in it. The barcode is required upon entry public establishments or facilities in Indonesia.

### **Electronic Health Alert Certificate (e-HAC)**

All international travellers are required to complete e-HAC before travel. Please download "Peduli Lindungi" app in your Apple Store or Android Play to complete the e-HAC. You will get a unique barcode at the end of the process and will have to show it upon check-in and arrival. If you are traveling with family, you are only required to create one account. For example, if a parent is travelling with his/her children, the parent is required to put his/her dependent information under his/her name.

As per today's updated information (May 12, 2022) from Indonesia government, for the Badminton Tournament, Indonesia Master and Indonesia Open 2022 in Jakarta, the government has not allowed us to apply for a Visa on Arrival for everyone since this type of visa is for Tourism purposes. With this updated information, we need to apply for e-Visa (Business Visa) in advance for everyone who will come and join this tournament. Another update from the government is the visa fee is now higher than last year due to the increase of tax in Indonesia, the **visa fee is now USD 250 per person**, including visa fee and visa and immigration assistance at Jakarta's airport.

### **e-VISA Requirements:**

1. Scan of Cover passport (outside or front part of passport).
2. Colour scan passport (minimum 1 (one) year validity from a month of arrival in Indonesia and have minimum of 4 (four) blank pages inside the passport upon arrival in Indonesia). **Important Notes:** the passport that we will use to process the visa here, **has to be exactly the same one** with the passport that everyone will use to enter Indonesia for the tournament.
2. Colour photograph (passport-sized, jpeg file, clear background)
3. Covid-19 Vaccine Certificate (at least 2 dose, only Janssen / J&J Vaccine allows to be only 1 dose as per legal regulation), which is administered at least 14 (fourteen) days before departure as a requirement for entering Indonesia, must be written in English other than the language of the country/region of origin of arrival.
4. Health/Medical Insurance Certificate/Card of each traveller (general medical / travel insurance is fine) which stills valid at least until the date of departure from Indonesia with a minimum coverage value of USD 50,000 which states and includes financing for handling COVID-19 and medical evacuation to a referral hospital with a minimum coverage value as determined by the organizer, manager or local government authorities.
5. Fill in and sign electronically, a "Visa Application Statement Letter", for each travelling party.
6. Return flight ticket (arriving in and departing from Indonesia) with your name stated on it.

Indonesian Government might change the regulation considering COVID-19 case every week in Indonesia and/or require more data/documents for the e-Visa process, however as of May 2022, above are the updated information one.
