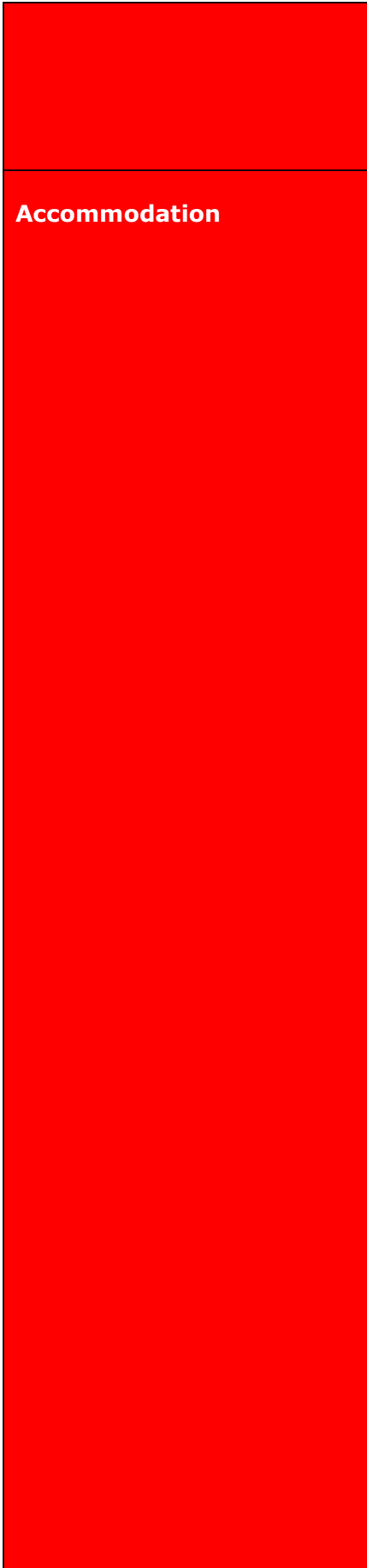

Entry into Thailand	<p><u>Entry into Thailand (as of 1 March 2022)</u></p> <p>A) <u>Test and Go Scheme for Fully Vaccinated Travelers</u></p> <p>Fully vaccinated passengers travelling from all countries/territories are eligible to apply under the ‘Test and Go’ scheme. The scheme will require each traveler to do an on-arrival PCR test at a designated hotel and stay in the hotel for a day/night and will be release upon a negative PCR test result. IMPORTANT : a fully vaccinated traveler must register for 'Test and Go' scheme at the Thailand Pass Portal to avoid doing more than a day quarantine.

B) Unvaccinated travelers

As per Thailand Government entry regulations, international travelers who are **unvaccinated or not fully vaccinated** must undergo mandatory quarantine of 10 days in a designated quarantine hotel in Bangkok, Phuket, or Samui before they can travel to other parts of Thailand. During the quarantine it is not permitted to leave the hotel room. **Unfortunately, it is not possible to gain an exemption from this quarantine for TUC participants.**

Pre-arrival preparation for all Travelers regardless of Entry Scheme

- 1) Valid Passport
- 2) VISA if required
- 3) RT-PCR test Negative certificate. (Test to be done within 72 hrs before departure to Thailand)
- 4) An insurance policy with coverage no less than US\$20,000. (The policy should cover the cost of treatment and other medical expenses associated with being infected with COVID-19, including in-patient hospitalisation, hospital isolation, hotel isolation, or related quarantine. The insurance policy should also cover the whole duration that travellers are planning to stay in Thailand, plus at least 10 extra days as a precautionary measure in the event that the traveller's second swab test result returns as positive.)
- 5) Register for Thailand Pass. Please be advised that the processing time for Thailand Pass is 3–7 working days. Applicants are advised to plan ahead and apply in advance for Thailand Pass at least 7 working days before their intended departure.
- 6) Vaccinated Certificate for fully vaccinated travellers
- 7) Recovery Certificate for recent recovered travellers 14-90 days of infection

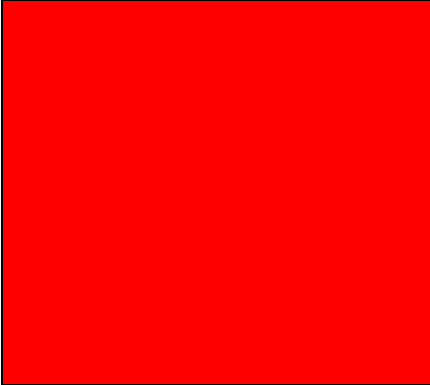

	<p><u>'Test and Go' Scheme</u></p> <p>1) <u>Arrival dates</u></p> <p>Due to the above testing, Players and team officials competing at the TUC2022 are strongly encouraged to arrive on 3rd or 4th May as the practice starts on 5th May at the Practice Hall and 6th May at the competition hall and must arrive by 6th May. Please note that only with a pre-arrival negative PCR test result and on-arrival negative PCR test result will a participant of the tournament be allowed to practice/play/officiate.</p> <p>Participants must reach the SHA Extra+ hotel before 7pm in order to do the on-arrival test on arrival day. Participants arriving after 7pm to the SHA Extra+ hotel will have to do their on-arrival test the next day and continue to stay in their hotel room till a negative test results is registered.</p> <p>2) <u>Mandatory requirements to stay in Official hotels</u></p> <p>Novotel and Ibis are both SHA Extra+ hotels. For local participants, a Pre-arrival PCR test must be done within 72hrs before check-in into official hotel.</p> <p><u>A2. Tournament On-arrival PCR test</u></p> <p>All participants must do an on-arrival PCR test. The tournament will accept the on-arrival PCR test done for 'Test and Go' scheme as the Tournament On-arrival PCR Test. For local participants, an on-arrival test will be done when participants check in into the official hotels and must stay in the room until the results are out.</p> <p>Please note: The cost of the pre-arrival test, the on-</p>



arrival test and day 5 ATK test as required under the 'Test and Go' scheme will be borne by each individual participant.

The BWF and Badminton Association of Thailand will implement other Covid-19 tests throughout the tournament. More details will be made available in due course.

Depending on the results of the Covid-19 test, an individual might be required to undergo more Covid-19 test in accordance with local health requirements.

Important Note: Hotel and Transport arrangements list above are as of first published date of invitation letter. There may be changes to arrangements made subject to prevailing Covid-19 measures set by the local government authorities.

Entry Scheme into Thailand through **TEST AND GO**

(Revised measures effective from 1 March 2022)

ELIGIBILITY

Fully vaccinated* travelers from all countries / territories

*Only vaccines registered by the Food and Drug Administration of Thailand or approved by the Ministry of Public Health or the WHO and received at least 14 days prior to departure



REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- 1 Passport
- 2 Certificate of Vaccination
 - Aged 12-17 may be vaccinated with only 1 dose of vaccination
 - Unvaccinated children aged under 18 must register and travel with their parent or legal guardian
- 3 Paid SHA Extra+ / AQ Hotel booking confirmation for 1 day including the fee for 1 RT-PCR test, 1 ATK self-test kit and airport transfer
- 4 Insurance with minimum coverage of 20,000 USD for medical expenses (not required for Thai nationals and foreign nationals who have Thai social security / confirmation letters from employer in Thailand)

STEPS

- 1 Register on Thailand Pass (processing time is 3 to 7 days)
- 2 Prior to departure, obtain RT-PCR test result issued within 72 hours before departure (If tested positive, a medical certificate indicating that your first date of infection is at least 14 days but no more than 90 days before your date of departure is required)
- 3 Upon arrival in Thailand, pass through designated checkpoints before proceeding to your hotel via a sealed-route (airport transfer arranged by hotel)
- 4 Undergo a RT-PCR test and wait for test result at your hotel
- 5 Take ATK self-test on Day 5-6 and report the test result as instructed by the Ministry of Public Health

Annex 3 – Steps to apply for Thailand Pass (under the 'Test and Go' Scheme)

Application for Thailand Pass is free, however, each participant must make payment for the 1 night stay at the SHA Extra+ Hotel for the on-arrival test under the 'Test and Go' Scheme before making application for the Thailand Pass. The payment will include 1 night stay in the SHA EXtra+ hotel, 1 RT-PCR test and 1 ATK test for Day 5 testing and transport from Airport to SHA Extra+ hotel.

Step 1 : Book SHAExtra+ hotel for 1 night stay. (e.g. If arrival is 4 May, book for check in on 4 May and check out on 5 May). Get receipt of payment and scan into jpeg file for upload onto Thailand Pass portal

Step 2 : Prepare soft copy files of passport and vaccinated certificate in jpeg format. Prepare the QR code of the vaccination doses in jpeg format. Prepare in jpeg format, certificate of insurance with at least USD20,000 coverage for at least the duration of the trip.

Step 3: Prepare pdf versions of all above documents to be uploaded onto the portal under other documents.

Step 4 : Once you have all the documents in the correct format ready, Click on the Thailand Pass link <https://tp.consular.go.th/> and process to make application following the steps in the portal.
